

Quick & Easy Mesh Market Bag

About: This tote works up very fast (took me about an hour), looks nice, and stretches to fit just about anything from books to produce.



Construction: The pattern involves making a chain and using 3 rows of DC with increases at the end to create an oval shaped bases. The sides are made with a DC+chain 1 pattern. The top is reinforced with 2 rows of DC. The straps are CH, DC, and SS.

Required Materials:

- 2 skeins of 100gr chunky or t-shirt yarn
- size 8mm crochet hook

Abbreviations Used:

The pattern uses the following US crochet terms:

ch=chain	st=stitch
dc=double crochet	sk=skip
sc=single crochet	ss = slip stitch

Let's Get Started!

Base: ch 23

Round 1: dc 5 in the 4th ch from the hook. Dc in the next 18 sts (until you reach the last ch), dc 6 in the last ch. Dc in each st around the other side to form your oval base. Join with a ss. **[48sts]**

Rounds 2: ch 3, dc in the next st, dc 2 in each of the next 2 sts, dc in the next 22 sts. Dc 2 in each of the next 2 sts, dc in the next 20 sts, ss to join **[52sts]**

Round 3: ch 3, dc in the next 2 sts, dc 2 in each of the next 2 sts, dc in the next 24 sts. Dc 2 in each of the next 2 sts, dc in the next 21 sts, ss to join **[56sts]**

Round 4: ch4, sk 1 st. [dc in the next st, ch1, sk 1 st] all the way around, ss to join **[28sts]**

Rounds 5-11: ss into the ch 1 sp, ch4, sk the next dc st. [dc in the ch 1 sp, ch1, sk the next dc st] all the way around, ss to join **[28sts]**

Round 12: ch3, [dc in the ch 1 sp, dc in the next st] all the way around, dc in the last ch 1 sp, ss to join **[56sts]**

Round 13: ch3, dc in each st all the way around **[56sts]**

Handles:

Round 14: [ch 34, sk 14 sts, sc in the next 14 sts] repeat once more, ss to join **[28]**

Round 15: dc in each of the 34 chs, sk the next 2 sts, sc in the next 10 sts, sk the next 2 sts and dc in each of the next 34 chs, sk the next 2 sts, sc 10, sk the last 2 sts, ss to join **[88]**

Round 16: ss in each st all the way around **[88]**

Finishing: Fasten off and weave in any loose ends.
